Farrow, Eastfield, Feoffee Common Lane (Yapham PC) – change of use of land for holiday use including erection of 2 holiday lodges, siting of 1 lodge, use of existing shed as bin store, excavation of a lake, internal access roads & landscaping works (retrospective), & siting of 2 additional holiday lodges & erection of a staff facilities building with assoc. parking (Resubmission of 23/00896/PLF) – **(Ref: 24/00214/PLF)**.
