

**Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Thursday, 13 December 2012**

**at 7.30 pm in the Village Hall, Barmby Moor**

**Present:** Councillors Spencer, Laverack, Van Dam, Vass, Shepherd, West, Haynes and Woods.

**Apologies:** Received from Councillors Pocklington and Inglis.

**Declaration of Interests from members on any item to be discussed:** None.

**Minutes:** Minutes having previously been circulated (noted to have the wrong date in the typed minutes), otherwise agreed to be a true record. Prop. Cllr Shepherd, seconded by Cllr. Vass and motion carried.

**Matters Arising:**

**Upgrading Street Lights in Back Lane** – lights to be removed are Columns 3 & 5 and to keep Column No. 6.

**Bus Shelter Windows** – quotation from The Plastic People = £60.92 inc. VAT + delivery. Prop. to accept Cllr. Van Dam seconded by Cllr Laverack and motion carried.

**Yorkshire Water** – Pumping Station being upgraded and problems during the heavy rainfall with sewerage running into the village beck from the blocked manholes. Cllr. Spencer has been liaising with YW and their Contractors (Bentley's). Solution Technicians due to call Cllr.Spencer in the next few days.

**Problems parking outside the school** – Cllrs. Spencer and Laverack had a meeting with the Head Teacher, who will review the school file on this problem. Due to meet again in January.

**Accident A1079 at Florida Keys/The Squirrels** – Phil. Hiscott has passed this request to the Forward Policy Unit and has been included for appraisal in the next Local Transport Implementation Plan.

**Gliding Club** – received copy of public footpath which is across the Airfield. Prop. Cllr Spencer, we ask ERYC to re-route the footpath to avoid the runway. Seconded by Cllr. Shepherd and motion carried.

**Streetscene/Taskforce** – waiting for response after update of report sent from Cllrs. Spencer and Vass.

**Litter Bins** – Cllr. Laverack request a new litter bin on the corner of Manor Garth and St. Kildas. ERYC suggest Wybone LBV/6 current cost £252.07 + VAT and £96.00 installation + VAT.

**Bollards outside Village Hall highways verge** – no response from Highways.

**Annual Play Park Inspection** – requested through ROSPA. Consider precept for climbing rope and ladder.

**Proposed development at Jesfield and St. Catherine's Cottage** – email from Rollits saying Quicksilver Homes want two Deeds of Grant of Easement to be provided. Both rights of way upon the VG being deregistered – one for 8 houses and the other for 10 if the land to the rear of the PO becomes available.

After a long discussion members agreed to continue with the original Deed of Grant of Easement for £75,000 for the 10 houses (as D of G have been signed previously). Prop. Cllr Laverack, seconded by Cllr.Haynes and motion carried unanimously. Clerk to inform Rollits.

**Play Park** – play equipment at Little Weighton provided by SJ Danby of Elvington.

**Parish/Church Magazine** – letter from Christine Gardham on behalf of PCC suggesting the Parish Council becomes involved with the magazine and expands delivery to each household in the parish. Prop. Cllr. Laverack seconded Cllr Woods to pay a grant of £246 for 2013 (April/May).

**Sutton Lane** – fractures at a manhole has been reported to Highways.

### **Reports from Councillors after attending meetings:**

**Calley Trust** – Cllr Haynes reported on two Christmas Dinners at the Boot & Slipper for 70 OAP's in the parish.

**Winter Services** - Cllr. Spencer confirmed that ERYC encourage people to clear the paths and verges in front of their homes during heavy snow. They should have no concerns being sued through insurance claims by doing this.

**Environmental Services** – Cllr Vass reported that July/Aug/September the blue bin collections will be fortnightly.

**Youth Support Services** – Cllr. Vass submitted information on grants available for young people aged 5 – 19 in established or new groups which need funding. Clerk put posters on the Notice Boards.

**Councillors requests on items for future agenda (AOB) –**

**Keldspring Lane** – a local resident requested a weight restriction order on this lane.

**Bottom of Chapel Street/Beckside** – leak from owners property which runs into the beck and across the road. Report to ERYC.
