Parish Update

Barmby Moor Development Plan

Consultations with residents on the proposed Plan were held in October and November and were well attended. Feedback was positive. The Plan has been amended where appropriate as a result of the consultations. In addition, the Government has published a revised version of the National Planning Policy Framework. The Plan has also been amended for compliance with this revised document, and references to and extracts from amended accordingly. At the time of writing (mid-January 2019), the Plan is undergoing a final edit and proof-reading. It will then be submitted to East Riding of Yorkshire Council for further consultation and inspection. A successful inspection will lead to a referendum, which if receives sufficient positive votes should lead to the Plan being adopted. The latest copy of the Neighbourhood Plan is available for download on the Parish Council website.

Kerbing the village green at Beck Side – hope you all are pleased with the completed kerbing at Beck Side. The Parish Council decided after last year's terrible damage and erosion to the verges, kerbing is the only way to preserve the village greens for the future. However, unfortunately a large vehicle has driven over the green in this area, damaging the grass. If you witness a reckless driver doing this damage, please get in touch with the clerk or a parish councillor giving details of the vehicle.

Holborn Estate/The Orchard verge parking area – this issue will be discussed at the January meeting and will be reported in the next parish update.

Tree pruning – has been carried out in the Play Park and the willow trees at Beck Side.

Bus Lay-by A1079 opposite Kimberley House – complaints have been received on the state of this bus lay-by. It was eventually cleaned by ERYC Street Cleansing Department in December.

Parish Precept 2019/2020 – for the fourth year running, the precept for the parish has remained the same. This will mean that the band D billing amount will be £51.07 which is an increase of £1.82 and 3.70% compared to 2018/2019.

Chairman of the Parish Council – due to work commitments, Councillor Robert Hill has had to resign from this position. Members of the PC wish to pass on their thanks for all his hard work over the years.

Local Elections 2019 – will be held on the 2 May 2019. Parishioners who are interested in becoming a Parish Councillor please look out for the notices on the Parish Notice Boards, Barmby Moor's website and also this parish update.
