Parish Update

Co-option of two Parish Councillors – members are very happy to welcome two new councillors who were Co-Opted onto the Parish Council at a recent meeting. Welcome to Bronya Emmison of Main Street and Gareth Dexter of Sutton Lane.

Tour de Yorkshire – just to let you know the grant received from the East Riding of Yorkshire Council was completely used for purchasing materials and bunting etc., for the event. We now have a stock of yellow and blue bunting which can be used for future events in the parish. Get in touch with a Parish Councillor or clerk if needed.

Barmby Moor Parish Council's website – there are several local groups and committees in the village. Please get in touch with the PC, you can advertise on the website free of charge, current events or even minutes of your meetings. This might attract more local residents joining your group.

Community Speed Watch – Humberside Police have now recruited a co-ordinator who will manage the scheme across the police force area. Wayne Goodwin previously launched and managed the Community Speed Watch in Lincolnshire and brings a wealth of experience to the role. Wayne is currently finishing his induction with Humberside Police and meeting local authority parties regarding his plans for the initial rollout of the scheme. A further update will be issued in the near future, when local volunteers will be needed.

Road safety issues in the village and Sutton Lane junction – members are liaising with East Riding of Yorkshire Council and Pocklington Provincial Ward members about road safety and traffic calming measures needed in the parish.

Parking outside the school during pick-up and drop-off times – the Parish Council have been in touch with Humberside Police PCSO's asking if they can help with the safety of children during these times outside the school. Complaints received about vehicles parking on the footpaths and grass verges, and the children having to walk on the road. Surely this is dangerous and wrong!!

Dog Fouling – complaints received about dog fouling in the village. Generally dog owners are very conscientious about cleaning up after their pets, but unfortunately a few are not responsible.

Bus Lay-by A1079 outside Barmby Moor House/Constantine House – no objections received about erecting a new bus shelter at this bus stop on the A1079. The Parish Council are therefore going ahead with the scheme.
