Parish Update

Play Park – repairs have been carried out to the horizontal bar and the baby slide. Members are looking into repairing the safety surfacing under the baby swings, and the possibility of new play equipment. Rospa will be carrying out their annual safety inspection of the play equipment sometime this month.

Community Speed Watch – Wayne Goodwin the Community Speed Watch Co-Ordinator, has asked the Parish Council to contact ERYC and to assess the sites we would like to set a speed watch. ER will in the first instance say that a speed survey would not be needed to set up a CSW Scheme, or that a full speed survey needs to be carried out with a view to adding it to the Safer Roads Humber list of enforcement sites. We will keep you updated, as volunteers are needed. Can residents of Sutton Lane, inform the Parish Council if they wish to have a Community Speed Watch Scheme, and if you would like to volunteer.

Willow Trees – Northern Powergrid (Amey Contractors) have inspected the willow trees at Beck Side which are growing into the overhead cables. They plan to carryout pruning works to the 9 x mature willows, 1 spruce and 1 silver birch. This will be done to BS3998 standards. A maximum of 3 metres will be gained from the conductors when pruning the willows; 1.5 meters will be gained when pruning the spruce and the silver birch. No dates given but if power supplies need to be shut down, local residents will be informed in good time. **Bus Lay-by A1079 outside Barmby Moor House/Constantine House** – The Parish Council are waiting for ERYC to lay a hard standing for the new shelter. Once this has been done a new shelter will be ordered.

Fly Tipping – last month someone decided to dispose of their tree pruning and garden refuse on the grass verges in Keldspring Lane. This caused a danger to traffic and also could have blocked the village beck. We are very lucky to have a tip situated down Burnby Lane in Pocklington. Please use this facility and do not expect others to remove your refuse.

Road safety issues at the Sutton Lane junction – PC has been in touch with a Highways Engineer asking for a central refuge at Sutton Lane end across the A1079. The request has been rejected once again. ER have no budget available to make such significant changes to the junction or road layout to accommodate a refuge.

Parking outside the school during pick-up and drop-off times - Humberside Police PCSO's will carry out occasional checks on car parking during drop off and pick up times at the school. Members are hoping to have future meetings with the school on safety issues for the children.
